AFTERNOON COURSE 1: Opioid Prescribing and Stewardship With Dr. Lisa G. Marin

This course is designed to provide the participant who has prescribing privileges in North Carolina, information regarding opioid prescribing, NC Controlled Substance Reporting System Registration and compliance and their stewardship in the battle against SUD and opioid use.

- Understand Post Operative Pain management is possible without the use of Opioid medication.
- Review the latest ADA guidelines for Acute Dental Pain in Adolescents and Adults.
- Know your limitations for Narcotic prescribing in cases of Acute Pain.
- Understand your obligation and registration with the NC Prescription Drug Monitoring System.
- Learn how to include patient counseling in post operative instruction to include the dangers of addiction and when and how to properly dispose of unused opioids to prevent abuse.

AFTERNOON COURSE 2: Substance Use Disorders, Mental Health, & Burnout (Mental Awareness) With Dr. J. William "Bill" Claytor

This 1-hour course will fulfill the NC State Board of Dental Examiners requirement for dentists and dental hygienists license renewal on mental health-related issues once every two years.

- Identify and discuss signs and symptoms of burnout and how to know if you are just having a bad day, overstressed or truly experiencing burnout.
- Examine the correlation between stress, depression, substance use disorder, and suicide as it relates to burnout in dentistry.
- Discuss 6 specific "mismatches" in the dental office plus other contributing factors that may be sources of burnout.
